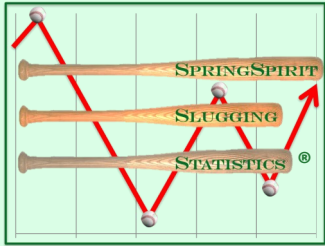

We are honored to create and chair the 2nd annual **SpringSpirit Slugging Statistics®** camp to be held the week of **June 8 – 12, 2020** at the SpringSpirit Youth Sports and Education Complex. We welcome your support of this impactful event which combines the SpringSpirit children’s love of sports with STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) lessons, engaging them with the power of these disciplines, providing them with leadership development, and inspiring them with an ambitious vision for what they can achieve.

SpringSpirit is a leading non-profit that invests in tomorrow’s leaders by holistically serving our city’s underserved youth. Their mission is to provide safe pathways for youth to realize life opportunities through sports, education and mentoring programs that are based on Christian principles. With your help and sponsorship, their most involved and dedicated students will be able to continue building their personal pathways to success.

The potential for impact is great, as SpringSpirit is situated in the heart of a high-density community, where there are an estimated 10,500 youth under the age of 18 within a 2-mile radius. A few facts about why we have chosen to support them:

- In 2019, SpringSpirit served 1,176 primarily Latino/a kids (ages 4-18) and their families
- Data from neighboring schools indicates that 97% of the students SpringSpirit serves are minority, 88% qualify for the free/reduced lunch program, and 81% are considered “at risk” of not graduating from high school
- Through their programs, SpringSpirit engages in nearly 39,000 community interactions each year

Our society is in an era of constant scientific discovery and technological advancement, and our economy will increasingly rely upon those who can lead in these areas. Investments in STEM education will empower and equip children to achieve their dreams, and enrich the future of the Houston community.

Proceeds raised will help underwrite a week-long STEM intensive summer camp, with sports and a leadership component, and provide more significant support for year-round enrichment in the areas of sports and STEM. Please consider supporting the children of our city in this powerful way at the **SpringSpirit Slugging Statistics®** camp during the week of **June 8 – 12, 2020**.
