Job purpose

The purpose of the Youth Ministry Intern is to assist the Youth Ministry Manager in sharing the Gospel and the love of God with kids who participate at SpringSpirit. He or she will be under the leadership of a Youth Ministry Manager whose primary goals will be focused on planning, organizing, leading and executing youth ministry activities.

Key tasks and responsibilities

- Interact with SpringSpirit youth and their families on a regular basis (5 or more times per week) with a special outreach emphasis on baseball, softball and soccer players while maintaining meaningful relationships with kids already active in ministry programs
- Work with the Youth Ministry Manager to lead both huddle groups (or other) and Friday Night Live programs
- Attend practices, games, lunches and other events to support SS students
- Assist with various afternoon and evening activities including, but not limited to the After School (Education), Recreation (CRL) and Sports (Toros, Lady Toros and Soccer) programs. In other words, be present at programs and functions in order to establish and maintain meaningful relationships with kids and their families
- Deliver weekly devotionals under the guidance of the Youth Ministry Manager at SS programs with a special emphasis on sports programming
- Help with the coordination for the spring break and summer programming
- Responsible for recruiting and registering kids for summer camps and may be asked to attend overnight summer camps
- Record attendance for ministry programs through metrics reporting system
- Comply with all SS policies and procedures
- Consider a volunteering as a mentor and Whole Child steward

Expectations

The SpringSpirit Youth Ministry Intern should be a youthful, fun, energetic and safe adult who loves the Lord. They should desire to grow in their faith. They should have the flexibility and desire to immerse themselves in the north Spring Branch community by interacting with youth at SSB.

- Leverage resources in an efficient and effective manner
- Present yourself in a positive, professional and Christian manner that builds community and partner connections
- Embrace SSB core values and mission goals
- Embrace and learn about the culture and people of Spring Branch, specifically Pitner rd.
- Constantly being aware of, and seek to minister to, youth participants who do not actively participate in programs that we offer
- Be willing to be reassigned to an area of ministry that matches gifting and abilities
- Be willing to lean into other tasks and/or projects as might be requested. These may be related or may not be related to primary tasks and responsibilities.
